13 Reasons Why, is an American television series developed by Brian Yorkey and based on the novel Thirteen Reasons by Jay Asher. It was broadcasted for the first time on March 31, 2017 worldwide on Netflix. Dylan Minnette plays Clay Jensen, while Katherine Langford plays Hannah Baker. Christian Navarro, Alisha Boe, Brandon Flynn, Justin Prentice, Miles Heizer, Ross Butler, Devin Druid, Amy Hargreaves, Derek Luke, Kate Walsh and Brian d'Arcy James also play the main roles.

Clay Jensen, a seventeen-year-old boy, receives a box containing seven cassettes from a friend, Hannah Baker, who died a few weeks earlier. These

seven cassettes are each made up of two listening sides and contain one of the thirteen reasons that prompted Hannah Baker to make this decision. Each side also corresponds to a person whom she considers responsible for her act. Confused by the reception of these tapes, Clay will quickly discover Hannah's revelations and the fact that her comrades are not really what they seem they are.
